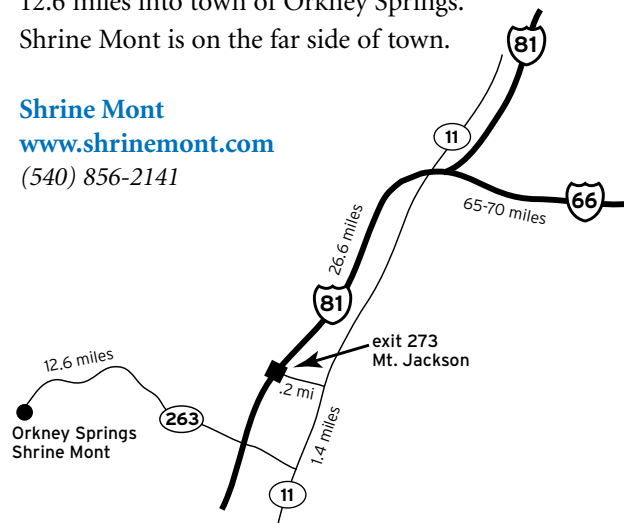

Directions to Shrine Mont

Shrine Mont is located in the town of Orkney Springs in the Shenandoah Valley, about 100 miles west of Washington, DC. Take I-66 west to I-81 (about 65 miles). Take I-81 south for 26 miles to exit 273–Mt. Jackson. At top of the exit ramp, turn left. Travel .2 miles to light and turn right on Route 11. Drive 1.4 miles and turn right onto Route 263. Drive 12.6 miles into town of Orkney Springs. Shrine Mont is on the far side of town.

Mike Honeycutt is Associate Professor of Historical and Practical Theology at Covenant Theological Seminary in St. Louis, MO. Prior to this position, Mike served as Senior Pastor of Southwood Presbyterian in Huntsville, AL. Before entering pasto-

ral ministry, Mike owned a real estate development firm in Myrtle Beach, S.C (where he worked a bit, played lots of golf and sailed). After sensing God's call to ministry, however, he received an MDiv from Covenant Seminary and PhD from the University of Edinburgh.

Mike serves on the Theological Examination Committee for the PCA, has taught preaching, Greek, and Church history at Covenant Seminary, the University of Edinburgh, and Ukraine Biblical Seminary, and has published in the areas of Church history and Church leadership.

Mike and his wife, Judy, have three children: Wade, a recent graduate of Auburn (War Eagle!); Wesley, a rising sophomore at Auburn (and a true character); and Mary Katherine, a rising senior in high school (and still a daddy's girl). Mike enjoys books, movies, snow skiing, fishing, lively theological conversation, and seeing the kingdom of God advanced through the local Church.

Retreat Details:

Departure/Return: You should depart by 5pm on Friday, August 21. Shrine Mont is about a two hour drive from the DC area. You are on your own for dinner Friday night. We will head back after lunch on Sunday.

Meals: Three meals on Saturday and two meals on Sunday are included in the cost (see registration form for cost details).

Accommodations: You do not need to bring bedding or towels (do bring beach towels). The Lodge charges extra for cribs, so bring your own Pack 'n Play for babies and toddlers.

Childcare: Children will have separate activities planned during all of the main retreat sessions. *(In a change from previous years, the children's sessions will have one adult volunteer present for each session this year.)*

Items to Bring: Bible, casual clothes, bathing suits, beach towels and a fan. Also every person/couple should bring chips or dessert and juice or soda for the refreshment table.
